Expenditure: The Deacons Court has in the last few months incurred expenditure of around £20,000 from the Property Upkeep Fund which is now depleted. The money was spent on the following items:

- A new bathroom in Hilton manse.
- A new shower & enclosure in Tain manse.
- Replacing a collapsed retaining wall in Tain manse driveway.
- Repairs to Tain Hall roof to stop water ingress.
- Electrical testing and repairs at both churches and manses.
- Upgrading the loft insulation in Hilton Church.

There will be a special Property Upkeep collection on Sunday 19th May.

New Church: The Deacons' Court also agreed to go out to tender on the New Church building contract. This will happen in the next month or so. It is expected the old health centre building will be demolished within weeks, as soon as we can get the electricity supply disconnected.

Sabbatical: Alasdair will be taking a 12-week Sabbatical over the summer. The Sabbatical will commence on Monday 3rd of June and continue until the end of August. During that time, Andrew and the elders will deal with all congregational matters.
