Steadfast Global:

Around 365 million Christians are subject to "high levels of persecution and discrimination". This compared to 340 million in 2021. 1 in 7 Christians are persecuted worldwide. The number of countries ranked as conducting "extreme" or "very high" persecution has risen from 23 in 2015 to 55 in 2023. Keep praying for the work of Steadfast Global.
